How to Print My Zine

This zine is formatted for easy at-home printing on standard US Letter paper $(8.5" \times 11")$. To get the best results:

What You'll Need:

- Letter-sized paper (8.5" × 11")
- A printer that supports double-sided printing
- (Optional) Long-arm stapler and paper trimmer

⊟ Print Settings:

- Print on both sides
- Flip on the short edge
- Scale: 100% or "Actual Size"
- **Orientation:** Landscape
- Pages to print: All
- Set it to flip on the short edge



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If printing manually:

• Print **odd pages first**, then reinsert and print **even pages**, flipping on the short edge.

% Assembly:

- 1. Fold the sheets in half to form a booklet. Look at the page numbers to figure out which way to fold. Note that the cover and Page 2 should be on the *outside* of the fold (meaning that, when the page is folded correctly, you will see them on the outside). Follow this pattern if there are more than 2 pages to fold.
- 2. When all the pages are folded, assemble in order, placing the Page 2 folded paper inside the Cover folded paper, etc. For most zines, there are only two folded papers.
- 3. Staple along the center fold (optional)
- 4. Trim edges if desired
- 5. Enjoy!
